



## PEACE SIGNS Debrief Activity

Teachers: Live theatre is a very powerful experience for children. Students need to have the opportunity to process emotions and feelings that may surface after watching *PEACE Signs*. This exercise was created to help facilitate a debriefing session for your students and should be done as soon as possible after the Student Assembly.

### Creative Activity

- ❖ Once the students have the debrief activity page in front of them, you can instruct that they are to (choose any of the following):
  - Draw the perfect playground and write two sentences about how to make it safe.
  - Design the perfect peace mural.
  - Think about the play. Write about how the play made you feel.
  - Write a new PEACE Signs song.
  - Write a poem or story about violence prevention and conflict resolution.
  - Write a script for a play about how to increase the peace.
- ❖ Once the students are finished, feel free to have a few students share what they created with the class. The art work/writing projects can be displayed in the classroom or be used as a tool to help reinforce conflict resolution skills and get the students talking about their feelings.

### Class Discussion Activity

- ❖ Here is a list of questions to help facilitate a conversation with your students about the feelings and emotions that might have come up after watching the play:
  - What were some the problems that the characters were going through? How did they feel?
  - Who was your favorite character? Why were they your favorite?
  - When the characters in the play resolved their problems, how did it make you feel?
  - Did you learn any new ways of dealing with violence or bullying? If yes, what?
  - What can students at your school do to increase the peace?
- ❖ This discussion will be a major part of processing and communicating for the students and can also be used in conjunction with the creative activity.
