Dear educator,

Kaiser Permanente Educational Theatre Programs is very pleased to announce our latest offering, "**Mumferd's Safety Tales**". Mumferd teaches young children about safety through a live theatre presentation. During the presentation, children will learn about fire safety, how to make snacks without using a stove or dangerous appliances, and gun safety. To help the children remember these messages, they will receive an envelope to take home that contains an activity sheet and crayons so that they can help Mumferd find a safety route from a fire, as well as choose items that are safe to cook for a snack. In addition, there is information from the Red Cross focusing on safety for the entire family.

This program works a little differently than our other programs. It is a "classroom show", which means that the actors perform the shows for individual classrooms rather than in a big assembly. Then, the actors return a week later and do a follow up workshop in the same classrooms. Therefore, at least 2 dates need to be booked at each location. The show is about 30 minutes long including getting from class to class, as is the workshop. Therefore, shows can be scheduled every 30 minutes. The show can be performed up to 6 times in a day, and as many days as needed to accommodate your school. **This program is for K-2.** Please feel free to contact me at the number above or by email at larry.davis@kp.org for more details or to book the show.
