By the numbers:

- A maximum audience of **200** per show is recommended (up to 2 shows per day and multiple days can be scheduled to accommodate school size)
- The performance lasts around **50** minutes (one hour is needed for set-up, and one hour is needed for break-down)
- 'Give Peas a Chance' is recommended for **2nd** and **3rd** graders
- A **20" x 20"** foot flat floor and access to an electrical outlet are required for the performance area. This program is interactive and not suited for an auditorium or stage
