



Room Focus: Outpatient Setting

The outpatient setting features two provider offices as well as an exam room, medical assistant's station, reception area and waiting room. This space will allow Kaiser Permanente to evaluate new furniture and equipment before it becomes standard and will be used as a jumping-off point for the Future of the MOB initiative.

Safety by Design

- **New flooring standard** decreases slips, trips and falls, reduces noise, and lessens impact stress on legs and lower back
- **Power exam tables** in a higher percentage of exam rooms
- **Enhanced access** for special needs patients
- Exam room swing door is designed for **patient privacy**
- **Modular, flexible and adaptable** allowing "mixing and matching" to meet the needs of physicians, other clinicians, and non-clinical support staff
- **Ergonomic** reception station design
