

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY TRAINING COURSE APPLICATION

Course Description:

This course provides the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) registered technologist with a cognitive base of entry-level education in the practice of computed tomography. Educational categories will include Patient Care, Imaging Procedures, and Physics and Instrumentation. Note: This course does NOT include a clinical component. The technologist must complete the Computed Tomography Clinical Experience Requirements in order to be eligible for the ARRT post-primary examination in Computed Tomography.
